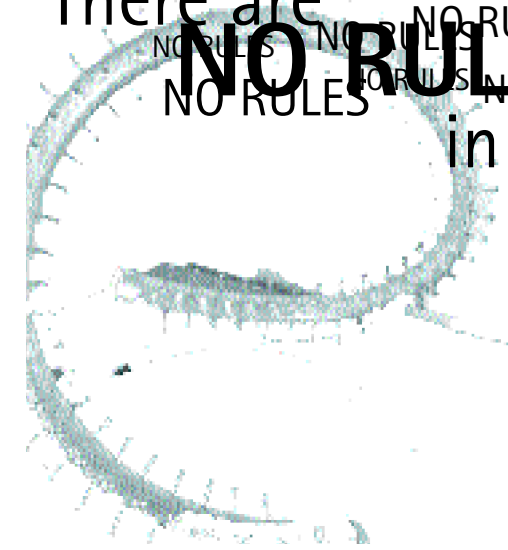
Instructors **Judy McElhone** and **Victoria Kneiring** had a two person show at the Creative Arts Workshop in New Haven in March.
